Bus - 612 Box Hill- Chadstone- Exit on the corner of Union Road and Montrose / Guildford Roads (Outside the Holy Trinity Hall)

Tram - No. 109 Box Hill- Port Melbourne- Exit at stop No. 53 on the corner of Whitehorse and Union Roads (the old Mont Albert Terminus shops)
